1. Introduction

UOP Learn is the official Learning Management System (LMS) of the **University of Peshawar**, used for delivering online and blended courses. Through UOP Learn, students can access course materials, submit assignments, attempt quizzes, participate in discussions, and view grades.

2. System Requirements

- A computer, laptop, tablet, or smartphone
 - Stable internet connection
 - Updated web browser (Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Edge)
 - PDF reader (for lecture notes and assignments)

3. How to Log in to UOP Learn

1. Check your email Inbox or spam folder
2. check your username login “Password” follow the instructions
3. Change your password at your first login and note it down in a secure place so you can remember it.
4. Open your web browser.
5. Visit **<https://learn.uop.edu.pk>**
6. Click **Log in**.
7. Enter your **UOP student username** and **password**.
8. Click **Log in** to access your dashboard.

14.1 Installing the Moodle App



1. Open **Google Play Store** (Android) or **Apple App Store** (iOS).
2. Search for **Moodle App**.
3. Install the official app developed by Moodle Pty Ltd.




14.2 Logging in to UOP Learn via Mobile App

1. Open the **Moodle App** on your mobile phone.
2. On the site address screen, enter: **<https://learn.uop.edu.pk>**
3. Tap **Connect to your site**.
4. Enter your **UOP username** and **password**.
5. Tap **Log in**.

Note: Use the same login credentials as the web portal.





14.3 Using UOP Learn on Mobile

With the Moodle Mobile App, students can:

- View enrolled courses
- Download lecture notes and resources
- Receive instant notifications for announcements and deadlines
- Submit assignments (file upload supported)
- Participate in discussion forums

- Attempt quizzes (if enabled by the instructor)
- View grades and feedback

Some activities, such as timed quizzes, are best attempted using a computer for stability.

14.4 Offline Access

- Course materials can be downloaded for **offline viewing**.
 - Once downloaded, content can be accessed without internet.
 - Internet connection is required for submissions, quizzes, and syncing progress.
