## Moodle Guidelines

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### For Teachers

#### 1. Logging in:

- Go to your Moodle site URL using a web browser <http://learn.uop.edu.pk>

#### 2. - Enter your provided username and password.

- Click Login.

- If you forget your password, use the 'Forgot password' link to reset.

#### 3. Adding a Course:

- From the dashboard, click 'Create Course' or 'Add a Course'.

- Fill in Course Name, Description, Category, and Summary.

- Set Course Start and End Dates if applicable.

- Choose course format (Topics, Weekly, or Single Activity).

- Save changes.

#### 4. Adding Content:

- Turn editing on by clicking 'Turn editing on' in the course page.

- Use 'Add an activity or resource' for:

- \* Assignments: Collect student submissions.

- \* Quizzes: Add multiple-choice, true/false, short answer, and essay questions.

- \* Files/Resources: Upload PDFs, Word docs, videos, or links.

- \* Forums: Create discussions for students to participate.

#### 5. Managing the Question Bank:

- Go to Course administration → Question bank → Questions.

- Create categories to organize questions by topic.

- Add questions individually or import from CSV/Moodle XML files.

- Preview questions to check formatting and correctness.

- Use the question bank when creating quizzes or practice tests.

#### 6. Monitoring Student Progress:

- Go to 'Grades' to check scores and progress.

- Use 'Reports' to see activity logs, quiz attempts, and forum participation.
  - Send feedback directly through assignments or messages.
  - Track student engagement to identify struggling students.
7. Communication and Announcements:
- Use Announcements forum to post updates or reminders.
  - Enable notifications so students receive emails for important updates.

## **For Students**

### 1. Logging in:

- Visit the Moodle site URL using your web browser <http://learn.uop.edu.pk>.
- Enter your username and password provided by your institution.
- Click Login.
- If you forget your password, click 'Forgot password' to reset.

### 2. Accessing Courses:

- After login, go to Dashboard → My Courses.
- Click on the course you want to access.
- Check the course overview to see available modules, topics, and activities.

### 3. Participating in Activities:

- Assignments: Submit work before deadlines using the 'Add submission' button.
- Quizzes: Attempt online quizzes; check time limits and instructions.
- Forums: Post messages, reply to peers, and follow discussion threads.
- Resources: Download lecture notes, PDFs, videos, or links uploaded by your teacher.
- Activities may have completion tracking; mark them as complete if required.

### 4. Using the Question Bank (if allowed):

- Access practice quizzes provided by teachers.
- Attempt questions multiple times to improve understanding.
- Review correct answers and feedback after completion.

### 5. Tracking Progress:

- Go to Grades to check marks for assignments and quizzes.
- Check Activity Completion to see completed and pending tasks.
- Regularly review your dashboard for announcements and updates.

### 6. Communication:

- Participate in forums to communicate with teachers and peers.
- Use messaging to ask questions privately to your teacher.
- Always read announcements for course updates and deadlines.

Tip: Always log out after using Moodle, secure your password, and check notifications daily to stay updated.
